VFW/Loudoun County VFW Post 1177 History

- VFW began in 1899 with veterans of the Spanish American War
- Veteran organizations banded together in 1914 before WWI
- VFW chartered in 1936, just one year before VFW Post 1177
- 1950 VFW 1177 acquired one acre on Old Waterford Road
- 1960 the VFW built a block building on that property.

Activities of VFW Post 1177

- Work with County Vet Coordinator to Provide Relief for Veterans in Need +\$20K/yr. Poppy Program
- Veteran Services, Service Officer for veterans' benefits assistance
- Color Guard, Honor Guard, Rifle Squad, Bugler (Ceremonies and Funerals
- PT17, Military Order of the Cootie for VA Hospital/Nursing Home Visits, "Honor Order of VFW"
- VFW Auxiliary and Riders
- Support local National Guard Unit, C Company, 3/116th Inf.) and community
- Sponsor for Scout Organizations

- Sweats for Vets/Flag Retirements
- Leesburg Memorial Day Ceremony
- Leesburg Independence Day Parade
- Veterans Day Sunrise Service at Balls Bluff Cemetery
- Patriotic Programs: Patriot's Pen, Voice of Democracy, Recognize Teachers and Law Enforcement
- Naval and Air Force Junior ROTC Awards Recognition Program
- Provide the Meeting Space for American Legion, Scouts, and other civic organizations
- Storage Areas for American Legion, Scouts and facility maintenance













Maintaining our Heritage and Post Facility

- Constructed in the 1960's, added to in the 1970's
- Over \$100K in renovations over the past ten years:
 - 2010 new Furnace
 - 2013 new Roof
 - 2014 renovated Bathrooms
 - 2015 Property and Facilities deeded to all Loudoun Veterans through VSO
 - 2016 new Windows
 - 2017 connected to Town water
 - 2018 interior renovation: walls, floors, lighting, and fans
 - 2019 other renovations: drainage, roadway, signage, storage, security system, and grounds
 - 2020 connect to Town sewerage, Friends and Neighbors!
